


PLANETA wine

Ulmo is where everything began, between 1694 and 1994







1994 was our first vintage at Ulmo, around the fortified baglio which came into the family's ownership through marriage – exactly three centuries before, in 1694. Ulmo is the place of family memories and of our vision of the future; here in 1984 our first experiments with vines started. The journey began with the great international varieties - first of all our iconic Chardonnay, then Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Franc, and Syrah – followed by some traditional Sicilian varieties; Grecanico, Nero d'Avola and Grillo.





Oases of Capparrina

Extra Virgin Olive Oil
Sicilia I.G.P



Our agricultural ideal is a place like the Oasi di Capparrina, where plants, wild animals and countryside are protected by man. Porcupines, buzzards, foxes, owls, migrating birds and many other species inhabit the 149 hectares of olive groves and surrounding Mediterranean macchia, which slope down to the sea. Here we produce IGP olive oil of superior quality from Nocellara del Belice, Biancolilla and Cerasuola olives, which emerges from the little olive press within a few hours

of being harvested.





Vittoria Dorilli

Our Journey through Sicily began at Dorilli



Vittoria and its red sands almost like the seaside; looking ahead are the beaches of the Allied landings in 1943, and behind is the plateau of the Iblei. We are at Dorilli which we bought in 1997, 35 hectares, and the country house with its great courtyard between the Liberty style of townhouses and the rationalism of rural buildings. What pushed us in this direction was our fascination for Cerasuolo di Vittoria – the only DOCG in Sicily – and for Frappato, which gives Cerasuolo its unmistakeable presence.











Buonivini is balanced between agriculture and architecture





The micro-climate of Buonivini is extreme. It is our outpost at Noto, having one of the lowest rainfalls in Europe and with extremely limey soils, it is the ideal terroir for the two esteemed varieties of the area; Nero d'Avola and Moscato Bianco. We arrived here in 1998, and soon after we constructed the 'invisible winery' – an architectural project which is the quintessence of what we mean by respect for the countryside - we rebuilt the 'Case Sparse' and planted, next to the carobs and the olives, 7 hectares of almond trees and 40 hectares of vineyard.







Etna Sciaranuova–Feudo di Mezzo

Sciaranuova and Feudo di Mezzo are our idea of Etna





Sciaranuova lies along the route of the historic eruption of 1614; it is the first property we acquired on the northern slopes of Etna

in 2006.

Later on we planted 33 hectares of vines, between 600 and 890 metres above sea level, and established a winery in the Feudo di Mezzo district, perfectly concealed among the lava flows. Arriving on Etna to produce white mountain wines from Carricante grapes, we also planted Nerello Mascalese, as well as experimenting with Riesling and Pinot Noir.







Capo Milazzo La Baronia

La Baronia combines beauty, research and social responsibility







La Baronia is our most recent project, but the fullest of memories, of beauty and of social content.

We have managed the agricultural progress of this property belonging to the Fondazione Lucifero since 2011; it is a place of breathtaking beauty. The income deriving from the 8 hectares of vineyard contributes to their activities for the benefit of children. We have recovered a rare local variety, Nocera, and we produce Mamertino, a wine beloved by Julius Caesar, in the tiny 'collapsible winery', a further tribute to the

landscape.







Planeta Terra is a combination of activities, guided by the great environmental responsibility that as agriculturalists we feel is a true ethical imperative, deriving from a wider concept of social responsibility, always at the centre of our family and company choices. Arising from this, since 2021 every hectare of Vittoria, Noto, Etna and Capo Milazzo is certified as organic agriculture; and also from the next vintage all the Menfi vineyards will be certified by the SOStain[®] protocol following their adoption in 2011.









Hospitality

We are agriculturalists, and at the centre of our activities is wine. At the head of our priorities is respect for the countryside, for nature, for the communities where we work, and it has been a natural progression to work with hospitality, imagined as an enhancement of the landscape. Above all this has been through our wineries, each one of them has a well defined personality and this is shown in their particular welcome; in second place through our resort and restaurant of La Foresteria at Menfi, and also the holiday dwellings of Vittoria, Noto, Sambuca di Sicilia and Palermo.
